ACCOUNTING AND STATISTICAL NOTICE NO. 607

Proposed Revisions to the Massachusetts Private Passenger and Commercial Statistical Plans

CAR's Governing Committee, at its November 15, 2017 meeting, recommended modifications to the Massachusetts Private Passenger and Commercial Statistical Plans. The impacted pages have been forwarded to the Division of Insurance for promulgation pursuant to the provisions of G.L. c. 175A, §15. The following summary tables describe the recommended modifications and proposed effective dates.
