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MAIP Automobile Policy, Forms and Endorsements – Effective July 1, 2018

On April 13, 2018, the Division of Insurance placed on file CAR's adoption of the 2016 Edition of the Automobile Insurers Bureau's Massachusetts Automobile Insurance Policy including corresponding updates to related Forms and Endorsements for use in the private passenger residual market (MAIP) for new and renewal policies effective July 1, 2018 and subsequent. The filing, SERFF tracking number CARI-131381560, was detailed in CAR Bulletin 1046, dated February 23, 2018.

Please note that the Notice to Policyholders (2016 Ed.) was determined to be a suggested form only, and not filed as originally indicated. Accordingly, Assigned Risk Companies should use their own version of this Notice to comply with Massachusetts law requiring written notice of reductions and eliminations of coverages, conditions, and definitions in the current policy.
